

2025 ACCREDITATIONS

The accreditation period for the second edition of **ECAM FORUM** is now open. The accreditation is intended for audiovisual industry professionals, press and students. The accreditation is free of charge and grants access to the Forum's professional activities*, including project pitches, industry talks, and networking events.

The accreditation process is simple and can be completed through the FestiCiné platform:

On the platform, you need to create an account with your email address. Once you submit your accreditation request, you will receive an initial email confirming that your application has been received.

After the **ECAM FORUM** team validates your accreditation, you will receive a second email confirming your accreditation. Please note that the accreditation is personal and non-transferable.

HOW CAN I GET AN ACCREDITATION FOR ECAM FORUM?

The accreditation can only be requested through the FestiCiné platform:

Applications submitted through other means or outside the accreditation period, which will be open until May 26, will not be accepted.

WHICH FORUM ACTIVITIES CAN I ACCESS WITH MY ACCREDITATION?

With your accreditation, you will be able to access to:

- Project pitches in the sections ***Films to Come*** (feature films), ***Forum Shorts, and Series***.
- ***ECAM Forum Industry Platform*** at Festiciné. This includes access to consult and use the digital platform, including the Who is Who directory.
- ***ECAM Forum - Industry Talks***. Talks, presentations, and panels about the current state of the audiovisual industry.
- Access to the professional ***Forum space in Sala Taller***.
- ***Daily networking*** events from June 10th to 13th at Matadero.
- Presentations of professional ***activities, cocktails, and selected events***.

All these activities have free access with accreditation until the venue reaches full capacity.

CAN I ACCESS ALL THE TALKS AND SEMINARS WITH MY ACCREDITATION?

On one hand, your accreditation will allow you to attend industry talks until the venue reaches full capacity.

However, activities organized by **ECAM FORUM** in collaboration with Cineteca and Filmadrid—such as the conversation series *The State of Things the Masterclass and the screenings*—will require prior registration through the Cineteca website. Please note that there will be a fee of €3.50 for entry.

CAN I ACCESS LAST PUSH (WIP) SCREENINGS WITH MY ACCREDITATION?

Unfortunately, accreditation does not grant access to the Last Push screenings, as they will be closed-door events exclusively for programmers, distributors, and sales agents.

WILL I BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MEETINGS WITH MY ACCREDITATION?

The accreditation does not grant access to the One to One meetings, as these are pre-arranged between the selected projects and the invited decision makers. However, your accreditation will give you access to the Who is Who at FestiCiné, where you can organize your own professional meetings.

CAN I ACCESS THE COCKTAILS AND FORUM EVENTS WITH MY ACCREDITATION?

With your accreditation, you will be able to attend the networking cocktails at Matadero from June 10th to 13th. All events are open to the public until the venue reaches its full capacity.

WHERE AND WHEN CAN I PICK UP MY ACCREDITATION?

You can collect your accreditation at the reception of Cineteca - Matadero (Pl. de Legazpi, 8) from June 9th to 13th.
